PRAYER



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PRAYER

Personal and corporate prayer were so vital to Jesus' life and ministry. He often went away to mountains, desolate spots and quiet places just to be with His Father.

Mark 1:35 (ESV)

And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed.

Luke 5:16 (ESV)

But he would withdraw to desolate places and pray.

Luke 9:28 (ESV)

Now about eight days after these sayings he took with him Peter and John and James and went up on the mountain to pray.

The disciples watched Jesus and recognized that prayer was the source of His power. Prayer itself was not foreign to them; it was a required Jewish custom and commandment from the Torah. There were specific prayers that were to be recited at set times of the day, prayers for Shabbat (Sabbath), and special prayers for holidays. So clearly they



knew to pray. So what was that disciple looking for when he asked Jesus to teach them to pray (Luke 11:1) like John taught his disciples? Perhaps it was to get the same results out of prayer that Jesus and John seemed to be getting. It is clear that for Jesus, prayer was less about saying things to God. It was more about being with God, connecting with Him, knowing His will and returning with strength to execute His purpose. This is what our times of prayer must result in.

How do we connect with God like that? How do we get there? We get there by the pattern He gave us in Luke 11:2-4 (NKJV) It starts with God and coming before Him, (Our Father in heaven) surrendering in worship to Him, (Hallowed be Your name) proclaiming His Kingdom and submitting ourselves to His kingdom rule, (Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven) depending on Him, (Give us day by day our daily bread) acknowledging our sins, (And forgive us our sins) forgiving others, (For we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us) and separating ourselves from evil forces. (And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one). Let's be honest: when we pray, how often do we completely surrender to God with pure humility and total surrender? How often do



we multitask during supposed times of prayer? When our time with Him is less about what we want and more about who He is then we have actually entered into that thing called prayer.

This month immerse yourself in prayer. Remember to pray for everyone and especially those in authority (1 Tim 2:1-3) You will see this directive again and again this month.

And when you pray, surrender totally to Him. Be with Him. Cut out distractions. Hear Him and know His heart. Forgive others. Hold no hostages in your heart. You will experience another level in God. That's when you will pray for real. Pastor Fiifi & Dr. Sybil

Matthew 21:22 [AMPC]

And whatever you ask for in prayer, having faith and [really] believing, you will receive.

Meditation: You have to have faith and believe when you pray. And that prayer? It must be aligned with the word of God for your answer to manifest. Your "whatever" must gel with His will, and once that's in place, boom! Pray by faith and really believe. Your answer will surely show up.

- 1. Praise the Father for hearing your prayers.
- 2 Ask God to turn doubt into faith
- 3. Believe. Really believe He will do it.
- 4. Ask the Holy Spirit to renew your strength.
- 5. Bring your petitions before the Lord.
- 6. Believe God and pray for someone's healing.
- 7. Declare: I will not give up. God has heard me.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Psalm 69:13 [AMPC]

But as for me, my prayer is to You, O Lord. At an acceptable and opportune time, O God, in the multitude of Your mercy and the abundance of Your loving-kindness hear me, and in the truth and faithfulness of Your salvation answer me.

Meditation: God loves you dearly and always hears when you pray to Him. But there is a time and season for all things including the manifestation of answered prayers. Do not allow delayed answers to stop you from praying and waiting on God. Keep at it daily for the God who hears is able and will answer. Amen.

- 1. Praise be to the God who hears you.
- 2. Pray that your faith will not waver.
- 3. Pray for acceleration of delayed requests.
- 4. Declare: now is my acceptable and opportune time for a miracle.
- 5. Call on the multitude of His mercy.
- 6. Cry: Answer me!
- 7. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Job 22:28 [AMPC]

You shall also decide and decree a thing, and it shall be established for you; and the light [of God's favor] shall shine upon your ways.

Meditation: A decree is a law. God has given us power and authority to decree things and they come to pass. When we speak His word/will that is a decision and a decree. When you decree His word, believe there is power in the name of Jesus to establish it. The light of God's favor shall shine upon your ways when you decide and decree!

- 1. Exalt the Lord your God who has favored you.
- 2. Ask for the grace to pray and hear His will.
- 3. Make decrees and decisions:
 - 1. There is a lifting up! Job 22:29
 - 2. He lifts up and saves the humble! Job 22:29
 - 3. No weapon formed against you will prosper! Is 54:17
 - 4. You will not die but live! Ps 118:17
- 4. Declare: the body of Christ will enforce His will on the earth.
- 5. Call the light of favor to shine on your ways.



PRAYER

1 Peter 3:7 [NKJV]

Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered.

Meditation: Dishonor in marriage hinders prayer. Children are admonished to honor their parents so they live long (Exodus 20:12). In a world where dishonor and reproach (Prov 18:3) are so rampant, we must honor each other. Do not let dishonor ruin your prayer.

- 1. Ask for forgiveness for dishonoring spouse, parent, elder, child, or anyone in authority.
- 2. Worship Him. Surrender to Him.
- 3. Pray for healing and restoration in marriage.
- 4. Pray for husbands.
- 5. Ask the Spirit of understanding to rule.
- Call for the inheritance of grace to empower couples.
- 7. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Romans 8:26 [NKJV]

Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered

Meditation: There are days when your strength fails, and other times when you don't even have the right words to speak. But praise God for the Holy Spirit. He knows the mind of God and makes intercessions on your behalf. The practice of praying in tongues is very critical in the Christian walk. Let the Spirit help you.

- 1. Pray in the Holy Spirit. Pray in tongues.
- 2. Ask Holy Spirit to show you what/how to pray.
- 3. Pray for the baptism of the Holy Spirit (again).
- 4. Ask for prayer revelations for difficult situations.
- 5. Cry out for help in your weaknesses.
- 6. Ask the Holy Spirit to empower you.
- 7. Make intercession.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

2 Chronicles 7:14 [NLT]

Then if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways,

I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land.

Meditation: There are many people in powerful places who have not been "called" by the name of Jesus. They are decision-makers but they work by pride and culture, not by His name. The called must arise and take their place. People who will be humble and seek His face. You are God's person. When you pray the land is healed and restored.

- 1. Pray for the called to arise and take their place.
- 2. Ask the Lord to strengthen the called.
- 3. Pray for courage.
- 4. Pray for protection over God-assigned leaders.
- 5. Declare: I am called by His name!.
- 6. Ask God to reveal false prophets.
- 7. Declare a transfer of power to God's called.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

2 Chronicles 7:14 [NLT]

Then if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways,

I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land.

Meditation: Humility and holiness are required. When was the last time you got humble in His presence? Have you willfully turned away from sin? Are you keeping your covenant with the Lord? The world needs God's elect to be serious about holiness and righteousness so the land can be healed. The world needs you!

- 1. Humble yourself. Kneel, bow, or lay down.
- 2. Ask God to show you any wicked ways in you.
- 3. Repent and turn away from all wrong doing.
- 4. Separate from familiar/comfortable sin.
- Ask God to reveal the roots of your desire for any familiar sins.
- 6. Detach yourself from all roots of iniquity.
- 7. Get rid of things in your space that draw you into wrong doing.



PRAYER

2 Chronicles 7:14 [NLT]

Then if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land.

Meditation: Intentional and strategic prayer leads to signs, miracles, and wonders. The intentional prayer in this verse involved humility, seeking God, and turning from sin. That prayer produced restored communities. So what is your prayer strategy today? What will you do intentionally to draw His power to restore?

- 1. Ask the Lord what He is requiring of you.
- 2. Pray for restoration in these areas:
 - i.The church. Bring it back to its first love.
 - ii.Governments, both local and global.
 - iii. The sanctity of marriage and families.
 - iv. Those battling with addictions.
 - v.People struggling with mental health issues.
 - vi. The lands that are torn by war.
- 3. Ask the Lord to restore you.
- 4. Praise God for restoration.



PRAYER

Matthew 6:8-10 [NLT]

Don't be like them, for your Father knows exactly what you need even before you ask him! Pray like this Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy. May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.

Meditation: Jesus debunked the religious leaders' ideas of prayer. He showcased that prayer is first and foremost worship and being with the Father. It is building a connection to the one who created you. Do you want to know his will? Don't be like them. Reverence Him in prayer!

- 1. Hallow (reverence) the name of the Lord.
- 2. Declare the Lord's will to be done on the earth.
- 3. Pray heaven's systems be duplicated on earth.
- 4. Ask God to teach you how to pray effectively.
- 5. Proclaim: Your Kingdom come soon!
- 6. Recite the Lord's Prayer. Mean it.
- 7. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

John 5:30 [NIV]

By myself I can do nothing; I judge only as I hear, and my judgment is just, for I seek not to please myself but him who sent me.

Meditation: How often do you listen when praying? There is a saying "If you want to make God laugh tell him your plans." Too often we make plans involving one sided prayer. You do all the talking, and never allow yourself time to hear what the Father has to say. Jesus only did what the Father told Him to do. That's the example we must follow Listen to Him

- 1. Invite The Lord into your prayer time.
- 2. Remove distractions. Stop multitasking. Pray!
- 3. Ask God to train your ears to hear His voice.
- 4. Declare your desire to hear from Him.
- 5. Command your ears to hear Him.
- 6. Ask God for guidance in your specific situation.
- 7. Dedicate 10 mins to sitting in silence waiting for Him to speak.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Mark 11:24 [ESV]

Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.

Meditation: Belief. It all starts there. This verse assures you that whatever you ask for or need you must first believe. If you believe in your heart that you have received it already, it shall be yours. Glory to God in the highest! When you increase your belief, God will respond. Believe. And then let God be God Amen

- 1. Repent for the times unbelief took up residence in your life.
- 2. Commit to a deeper connection with Him.
- 3. Thank God for how far He has brought you.
- 4. Separate yourself from anything hindering your belief system.
- 5. Pray that your belief will inspire others to believe in Christ.
- 6. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Jeremiah 29:12-13 [NKJV]

12Then you will call upon Me, and you will come and pray to Me, and I will hear and heed you.
 13Then you will seek Me, inquire for, and require Me [as a vital necessity] and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart.

Meditation: When? Then. Check out vs 11. When the seventy years are completed for Babylon... When the prophetic timings of God are complete, then. When we pray according to His timing He hears & heeds. In the prophetic time we seek Him desperately, vitally, and incessantly. It is time for something in your life. It's your 'then' time.

- 1. Call on Him.
- 2. Proclaim the set time to favor God's people.
- 3. Tell Him: Lord, I require you! I need you!
- 4. Give Him your heart and soul.
- 5. Declare that He will hear and heed.
- 6. Tell Him what you need. Ask for it!
- 7. Thank Him!
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Phillipians 4:6 [ESV]

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.

Meditation: Anxiety robs us in many ways. It steals your present, and sometimes even your future by conjuring up things that may never even come to pass. You must combat anxiety through constant prayer, thanksgiving, and humility. God did not give you anxiety. So take it off and return it back to its sender. In the name of Jesus Amen

- 1. Rebuke the spirit of anxiety.
- 2. Call for power, love and a sound mind. 2 Ti 1:7
- 3. Thank the Lord for all His blessing!
- 4. Declare that you will not be robbed of your future in Christ.
- 5. Raise a joyful noise before Abba Father.
- 6. Bring your requests before Him.
- 7. Welcome the Holy Spirit to move in you.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Matthew 5:44 [NIV]

But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you

Meditation: Let's talk about love. But not the kind of love that you have for your parents, spouse or children. God has commanded you to love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you. As a believer, you demonstrate the love of Christ to the world when you rise above hate by acting/reacting with the love of God, no matter what comes your way.

- 1. Pray for the heart to rise above hate.
- 2. Ask the Spirit of love to flow through you.
- 3. Pray for someone who doesn't like you.
- 4. Now pray for someone you don't like!
- 5. Declare: I will love my enemies!
- 6. Separate yourself from anything that represents wickedness.
- 7. Guard your ear/eye gates to see/hear what the Spirit is saying.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Luke 11:9 [ESV]

And I tell you, ask, and it shall be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.

Meditation: A.S.K. Ask. Seek. Knock. 3 simple and direct strategies of prayer. Have you asked anything of Him lately? Have you sought (searched and looked for) His face, will and presence? Have you knocked (gotten His attention) like the woman with the alabaster box? A.S.K. That's how to pray.

- 1. Praise God for His providence.
- 2. Ask God for the desires of your heart.
- 3. Worship Him. Search for His Presence.
- 4. Pray hard for a move of God. Knock.
- 5. Wait patiently on Him.
- 6. Give an offering, a sacrifice that costs you.
- 7. Pray fervently for doors, windows, opportunities and blessings to open up for your House of Worship.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Job 1:6 [NLT]

One day the members of the heavenly court came to present themselves before the Lord, and the Accuser, Satan, came with them."

Meditation: In the courts of heaven God (righteous judge), Jesus (advocate), Holy Spirit (mediator) and the elders (witnesses) are present. Your righteous judge rules on your behalf because you are covered by the blood of Jesus. Do you have a case? Rejoice. You are victorious because the blood of Jesus speaks better things over you!!!

- 1. Ask the heavenly court to convene.
- 2. Praise God for the blood of Jesus.
- 3. Ask if there is any accusation against you. Listen for an answer.
- 4. Repent and ask for forgiveness of anything revealed. Ask the blood of Jesus to revoke it. (Heb 12:24)
- 5. Present your requests or issues before the court.
- 6. Listen for the Father's judgment.
- 7. Thank the Father for ruling on your behalf.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Psalm 69:3 [NLT]

I am exhausted from crying for help; my throat is parched. My eyes are swollen with weeping, waiting for my God to help me.

Meditation: All of God's Children experience the silence of the Father at some point. But His silence does not mean He has left you. He who never sleeps nor slumbers and sees all things will always be with you. Like the psalmist, keep on crying for help in prayer. Your Father will show up and help you. Wait for your God to help you. Selah.

- 1. Exalt God your maker today.
- 2. Present your exhaustion to the throne of grace.
- 3. Exchange exhaustion for strength.
- 4. Plead with the Father to renew your strength.
- 5. Tell God: I am waiting on you.
- 6. Declare the peace of Christ over your mind.
- 7. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

James 5:14 [MSG]

Are you sick?

Call the church leaders together to pray and anoint you with oil in the name of the Master.

Meditation: There is physical sickness, emotional sickness, financial sickness.... All kinds of ailments are coming at you, so think about it and answer the question: are you sick? If you are a church leader, then God has put in you what is needed to minister healing (even if you are sick yourself). So make the call if you are sick. And if you are a leader, then have that oil ready. It's time to deal with sickness James 5:14 style!

- 1. Thank God for solutions to all your ailments.
- 2. Confess any sicknesses you see in yourself.
- 3. Pray for church leaders to rise in their full praying capacity.
- 4. Pray for unity amongst church leadership.
- 5. Pray for sick communities.
- 6. Call on the name of the Master!
- 7. Pray for a revelation of the mystery of the oil.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

James 5:15 [The Voice]

Prayers offered in faith will restore them from sickness and bring them to health. The Lord will lift them up from the floor of despair; and if the sickness is due to sin, then God will forgive their sins.

Meditation: Have you ever made a mistake that landed you in a bad situation physically? That's a good time to pray the prayer of faith with a church leader. Join your faith with theirs. That prayer of faith (or The Message Bible calls it "believing prayer") brings restoration and forgiveness of sins. It lifts you out of despair.

- 1. Build your faith.
 - i. Share your favorite Jesus miracle story.
 - ii. Share testimonies of God's healing power.
- 2. Pray the prayer of faith for healing.
 - i. For individuals. Call them by name.
 - ii. For communities and nations.
- By prayer, take yourself from sickness into health.
- 5. Ask the Lord to lift you out of despair.
- 6. Pray for forgiveness of sins.



PRAYER

Colossians 4:2 [AMP]

Be persistent and devoted to prayer, being alert and focused in your prayer life with an attitude of thanksgiving.

Meditation: Paul advised the Colossians to take prayer seriously, and he admonishes you to do the same. Your heavenly Father does not want you to have an irregular and bizarre prayer life. No. He wants you to be focused, diligent and thankful. Most importantly, He wants you to have a real prayer life. So get to it. Spend quality, focused time with Him

- 1. Thank God for the privilege of prayer.
- 2. Rebuke all distractions as you pray. Focus.
- 3. Command your eyes to open, and see what God shows you.
- 4. Persist. Pray again.
- 5. Tell the desire for prayer to rise in you.
- 6. Commit to make prayer a priority in your life.
- 7. Shift your attitude into thanksgiving.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Luke 18:7 [NLT]

Even he rendered a just decision in the end. So don't you think God will surely give justice to his chosen people who cry out to him day and night? Will he keep putting them off?.

Meditation: Even the unjust judge gave in and gave out a favorable judgment. So God the righteous judge will definitely rule in your favor. He hears every cry and sees every tear. Be patient. Keep appearing before His court day and night. Soon your Father the righteous judge will grant you your petition. He won't put you off! Hallelujah!

- 1. Thank God for His love for you.
- 2. Ask for forgiveness and repent from all unrighteousness.
- 3. Declare: I am His chosen person!
- 4. Cry out to the righteous judge for justice for your situation.
- 5. Pray against injustice & oppression in the land.
- 6. Thank God for ruling in your favor.
- 7. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Luke 18:8 [NLT]

I tell you, he will grant justice to them quickly! But when the son of man returns, how many will he find on the earth who have faith?

Meditation: Lots of issues, problems, distractions and injustices going on in the world. We learned in Luke 18:7 that God is going to grant justice. He will do it. But the real question is this: will He find you persevering in prayer and holding on to your faith? Jesus is coming again and He will be conducting a search. Be found with faith.

- 1. Proclaim: Jesus is coming again!
- 2. Declare that you have faith in Jesus Christ.
- 3. Proclaim swift justice in your life and dealings.
- 4. Pray for the body of Christ to persevere.
- 5. Say: He will find me full of faith!
- 6. Praise the Lord and rejoice!
- 7. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Proverbs 15:8 [AMPC]

The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination, hateful and exceedingly offensive to the Lord, but the prayer of the upright is His delight

Meditation: You know how you act when you are upset, but can you imagine what it's like when God is offended? God is exceedingly offended when the wicked pretend to worship. But when the righteous pray He is just tickled pink with delight! Picture that! What other option do we have? Get upright and pray! His delight means answered prayer!

- 1. Ask the Lord to forgive you for offending Him in any way.
- 2. Confess your sins and repent.
- 3. Reject any form of wickedness in you.
- 4. Stand up as a prophetic act of uprightness.
- 5. Commit to holiness.
- 6. Pray. Pray all kinds of prayer. Bring Him delight!
- 7. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Matt 26:41 [NKJV]

Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.

Meditation: Jesus returned to find his most trusted disciples sleeping instead of watching. Watchmen are always on the lookout to keep thieves out and to let the master in. Prayer is not just mindless babbling. Your spirit is willing. Be on the lookout. Identify God and align. Find where satan is lurking and kick him out. Or you will enter into temptation.

- 1. Pray in the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you overcome temptations.
- 3. Command your eyes to see with clarity.
- 4. Ask for revelation. Watch. What do you see?
- 5. Bring your flesh under submission.
- 6. Reject temptation.
- 7. Resist the devil. 1 Pet 5:9
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

2 Chron 6:21 [NKJV]

And may you hear the supplications of Your servant and of Your people Israel, when they pray toward this place. Hear from heaven Your dwelling place, and when you hear, forgive.

Meditation: King Solomon built a great and glorious temple for the Lord. But what is a temple if God isn't in it, and He doesn't hear prayers from it? That was Solomon's prayer. David prayed it too in Ps 28:2 that God would hear when he lifted his hands towards the sanctuary. There is something about a church building. Go there today and pray.

- 1. Read Psalm 145.
- 2. Declare: Our God is a promise-keeping God!
- 3. Bring your needs before the Lord.
- 4. Pray for ministries in building projects.
- 5. Call for resources and strength to build.
- Ask God to keep His promises to your House of Worship.
- 7. Pray for forgiveness and restoration.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

1 Thess 5:16-18 [NKJV]

¹⁶Rejoice always, ¹⁷Pray without ceasing. ¹⁸In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

Meditation: Even in the midst of trials, believers should recognize the immeasurable value of maintaining fellowship with God through frequent prayer. Our Lord Jesus himself prayed without ceasing. The will of God for you is that you never stop praying. Always pray with rejoicing and thankfulness. He will hear you.

- 1. Thank the Lord for everything!
- 2. Rejoice! Do your happy dance.
- 3. Commit your way to joy.
- 4. Declare that you will pray without ceasing
- 5. What is the issue you are having today? Pray. Don't stop.
- 6. Pray for your family and friends' healing and deliverance. Don't stop.
- 7. Pray: Lord I am ready to do your will!
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

James 5:16 [NIV]

Therefore confess yours sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.

Meditation: This is simple math. Confession plus prayer for others equals healing. When you do both of these things then you are positioned to receive your healing. Your prayers become powerful, effective, and heard by our Lord and Savior. So connect with others. Confess and pray. We need each other to survive.

- 1. Commit to fellowship with other believers.
- 2. Confess your sins. Ask God to cleanse you.
- 3. Declare: My prayers are powerful and effective.
- 4. Pray for someone the Lord lays on your heart.
- 5. Welcome healing into your life.
- 6. Pray for a move of God.
- 7. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Job 22:27 [NLT]

You will pray to him, and he will hear you, and you will fulfill your vows to him.

Meditation: Have you ever prayed and made a promise/vow to do something for God if He answers? Sometimes you remember these vows. Other times you forget to fulfill them and just run off with your blessing. Have you made a vow to God? Pray. Hear. Fulfill. It is not too late to fulfill the vows. It's a necessary part of answered prayer.

- 1. Ask the Holy Spirit to remind you of unfulfilled vows and broken promises.
- 2. Pray for forgiveness for all broken vows to Him.
- 3. Ask the Lord to fill your mouth with words He wants to hear
- 4. Commit to being consistent in your walk.
- 5. Pray. Prophesy. Worship. Talk to Him!
- 6. Praise God for hearing your prayers.
- 7. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3



PRAYER

Exodus 25:22 [AMPC]

There I will meet with you and from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim that are upon the ark of the Testimony, I will speak intimately with you of all which I will give you in commandment to the Isaelites.

Meditation: You enter the mercy seat by sacrifice and atonement. You access the Holy of Holies by giving up attitudes, pride, rights, and completely surrendering to Him. When you get in the space of knowing He is God and you are in serious need of forgiveness, mercy, and atonement...there. Right there He meets with you and you have true intimacy. That's prayer.

- 1. Humble yourself before the Lord.
- 2. Kneel. Bow. Raise your hands.
- 3. Tell Him you surrender and mean it.
- 4. Make a sacrifice as you pray.
- 5. Tell Him your truth. Be intimate.
- 6. Worship Him and hear His truth.
- 7. Be ready to do His will.
- 8. Pray for all especially those in governmental, social and economic authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3
